The Sunday Clubs Committee supports the following groups: Twinkles, Sparklers, All Stars, Galaxy, Galatic Hobos, Children's and Youth Council, Worship Band, Holiday Clubs and the Youth Group (name yet to be decided by the young people).

### Aim

Aim: To accompany children and young people on their journey with God

#### Objectives:

- 1. To help develop children and young people as disciples of Christ, through the provision of Sunday Clubs, so that they can be salt and light in the world.
- 2. To arrange for children to be prepared to receive Holy Communion.
- 3. To engage children and young people in the decision-making process at St. Mary's.
- 4. To recruit, train and support leaders and helpers.
- 5. To provide encouragement and assistance to the ministry of Twinkles.
- 6. To provide encouragement and assistance to other children's and young people's events.
- 7. To provide support for youth work ministry within St. Mary's.
- 8. To encourage and develop Christian leadership roles within the young people as they show interest and potential.

## Responsibilities

We undertake the following tasks:

- Find suitable teaching and learning material for use in the Sunday Clubs and preparation for Communion.
- 2. Decide which adults to approach to become involved in our children's and youth work
- 3. Plan and lead events which will complement and develop the teaching and learning in the Sunday Clubs and Youth Group.
- 4. Review and update the Sunday Club Volunteer policy every two years
- 5. Develop the ideas coming out of the Children's and Youth Council
- 6. Make suggestions to the Twinkle ministry team
- 7. Make suggestions to the Youth work ministry team

- 8. Undertake risk assessments
- 9. Conduct volunteer inductions and yearly feedback reviews and act on matters arising from these
- 10. Plan, resource and where appropriate lead volunteer training sessions

Communication between meetings happens via email and conversations at church. A copy of the minutes is sent to the incumbent for inclusion in the papers to be circulated to the PCC. A report is also sent, if required, detailing any decisions that need to be made by the PCC. This is done by the Chair of this committee.
